

## Privacy Policy

This is the Privacy Policy for the website currently located at <http://www.aicobrevetti.net> (the "Site").

Your privacy is important to us and we have prepared this Privacy Policy to explain how we collect, use, and protect Personal Information (defined below) and Non-Personal Information (defined below) when you visit the Site and your choices for managing your information preferences. By using the Site, you signify your assent to this Privacy Policy and the Disclaimer (Terms and conditions of Use) posted on the [Site](#)

### 1. Managing Information Preferences

You may review, correct, update, or change your Personal Information, or remove your Personal Information from our direct marketing efforts, at any time by contacting us at [info](#)

### 2. Information you choose to Submit

We collect information that personally identifies you, such as your email address ("Personal Information") only if you choose to share such information with us. For example, you may be required to provide us with certain Personal Information to register with the Site and at other times. The decision to provide this information is optional; however, if you decide not to register or provide such information, you may not be able to use certain features of the Site.

### 3. Information we automatically Collect

We automatically collect information that does not reflect or reference an individually identifiable user ("Non-Personal Information") to help us understand how our users use the Site. Like most Web sites, we automatically collect and use the data contained in log files. The information in the log files may include

- your Internet protocol address ;
- the type of browser or computer you use;
- the number of links you click within our website;
- the state or country from which you accessed our website;
- the date and time of your visit;
- the name of your Internet service provider;
- the Web page from which you linked to our website; and
- the pages you viewed on our website

Our site may use cookies (a small bits of text that our servers place into a file on you computer's hard drive) that uniquely identifies your Web browser to improve the quality of the Site, your preferences and login information. Most Web browsers are initially set up to accept cookies, but you can reset your Web browser to reject all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, be aware that this will disable some of the functionality on the Site.

### 4. How we use Personal Information and Non-Personal Information

We use Personal Information and Non-Personal Information for internal purposes only, such as to keep you informed about topics of interest to you. We will not sell, share, or rent Personal Information to third parties, and we will not otherwise disclose Personal Information to third parties, without your express permission or as expressly disclosed in this Privacy Policy.

From time to time, we might establish a business relationship with other persons or entities whom we believe trustworthy and whom we have asked to confirm that their privacy practices are consistent with ours ("Service Providers"). For example, we may contract with Service Providers to provide certain services, such as credit card processing, advertising, analytics tools, widget providers, data management services, Web hosting, and Web development. We provide our Service Providers with the information reasonably necessary for them to perform these services. Each Service Provider must agree to implement and maintain reasonable security procedures and practices appropriate to the nature of the information involved in order to protect your information from unauthorized access, destruction, use, modification, or disclosure.

In certain instances we may disclose Personal Information and Non-Personal Information when we believe it is necessary to identify, contact, or bring legal action against persons or entities in order to protect us or our users or when we believe that the law or legal process requires such disclosure.

#### 5. How Long We Keep User Information.

We generally keep user data on our server or in our archives for as long as we reasonably need it. We may alter this practice according to changing requirements. For example, we may delete some data if needed to free up storage space. We may keep other data for longer periods if the law requires it. In addition, information posted in a public section (Posts) could stay in the public domain indefinitely.

Data management requests are administered in an orderly manner to the extent feasible and within our direct control. Note: we have greater control over recently collected data than for archived data. Once data is removed from the system and archived, it may not be feasible to accommodate specific requests. In those cases, our general data retention policy applies.

#### 6. Public Areas

Please be advised that, whenever you voluntarily post information to any community or interactive areas of the Site, such information can and may be accessed by the public. This means that any person or entity with access to such information can potentially use it for any purpose, including sending unsolicited communications.

#### 7. Security

Information that we collect is stored on servers that we manage, using standard security procedures and practices appropriate to the nature of the information in an effort to protect information from unauthorized access, destruction, use, modification, or disclosure. However, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while we strive to protect information transmitted on or through the Site, we cannot and do not guarantee or warrant the security of any information you transmit on or through the Site, and you do so at your own risk.

## 8. Children's Privacy Statement

We do not knowingly collect Personal Information from children under the age of 13. If we become aware that we have inadvertently received Personal Information from a child under the age of 14, we will delete such information from our records.

## 9. Privacy Policy Changes

We may, in our sole and absolute discretion, change this Privacy Policy from time to time. We will post a copy of the Privacy Policy as changed on the Site. Your continued use of the Site constitutes your agreement to abide by the Privacy Policy as changed. If you object to any such changes, your sole recourse shall be to cease using the Site.
